

Spanish Legal Translations Cookies Policy

What are cookies?

Cookies are small files that are stored on your computer or the device you use to access the internet when you visit websites. Some cookies are essential to make sure the website works properly. Others such as performance cookies contain information about visitors to the website and how they use the site, for example, the pages they visit, preferences, etc.

Spanish Legal Translations complies with UK and EU data protection law regarding cookies. This policy explains which cookies are active on the website, what information they track and how to opt out or change the cookie settings.

What cookies does Spanish Legal Translations use and what are they used for?

When you visit the Spanish Legal Translations website, we may use any or all of the following cookies.

- **strictly necessary cookies** to ensure the website works properly and allow you to access the different pages. These cookies do not collect or store any information for advertising purposes or about user identity or preferences. They are temporary, session cookies that are automatically deleted after you have closed the web browser.
- **performance cookies** to monitor visitors to the website and provide statistical information, for example the number of visitors to the website, the pages visited, or how visitors found the website, so we can study usage and improve the website's performance.

Third Party Cookies

While some cookies are set by us, the website may also use third-party technology such as Google Analytics to gather statistical information about how visitors use the website. These cookies do not collect information in any way that allows them to identify the user. You can find more information about Google's privacy policy [here](#).
